### SUMMARY

Welcome to the AFC Big Supporters Survey 2020.

This is the third year of the survey for Aberdeen FC Supporters and once once again commissioned by the Inverness Reds Aberdeen FC Supporters Club.

The survey captures the views of supporters on a number of subject matters from the match day experience to AFC in the Community and this year the impact of the COVID-19 pandemic.

The majority of questions asked have remained the same so we can do like-for-like comparisons across the surveys.

Some questions were optional and come were mandatory, we removed incomplete or duplicate survey responses from the results.

The survey took place between 26 May 2020 and 30 September 2020 and was promoted via social media and online via the Inverness Reds website and the AFC DONScast.

Fans were invited to take part in the survey through an online web form. In total 2,000 fans participated which is up from last year (329)


#### **Supporters Demographics**

- In full-time employment







How many Aberdeen matches do you attend on average each season?




As the Scottish Premiership League season is 38 games in total, the assumption is that those attending 38 or more games have effectively attended all of the clubs' matches for the season.

Of those surveyed there is quite an even spread across the different groupings, with 10.5% of fans saying they attended all the club games, which is 3.2% higher than last year.





In general as per previous years there was a range of responses in relation to what decisions are not being enforced strongly enough by refs. These included:


- Simulation / Diving / Play acting / cheating









Do you pay a subscription to watch live football?



Did you suspend your subscription during lockdown?




Which subscription service(s) do you use to watch live football?







Which subscription channel(s) do you subscribe to, to watch live football?

Would you subscribe to an SPFL sports channel?





Which sports podcasts do you listen too?












How often would you prefer to receive communication from the club?





Do you consider the "added" benefits included as part of AberDNA are value for money?




Have you purchased an Aberdeen FC season ticket this season?




